



The double wheel castor

Before 1965, typical office chairs were fixed and lacked flexibility. Jørgen Rasmussen aimed to create a chair adaptable to any environment and suitable for a wide range of users. His approach to design prioritised the work environment and freedom of movement.

In 1965, Rasmussen developed the double-wheel castor, inspired by the flexibility of an aeroplane's front wheels. This innovative castor design reduced wear on floors and carpets and greatly increased user flexibility with its low-anchored connector.

Today, this Danish invention is used in countless industrial designs, enhancing the well-being and working conditions of millions of people worldwide


About the designer

Jørgen Rasmussen (1931–2024) graduated from the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts in 1955 and, soon after, established an architecture studio with his twin brother, Ib Jørgensen.

With a sharp focus on functionality and simplicity, Jørgen Rasmussen proved himself to be an exceptional furniture designer, with the Kevi chair standing as his masterpiece.

Originally designed in 1958 for the Danish company KEVI, the chair emerged from an initial commission to design a villa. This project led Jørgen to create the now-iconic office chair, which would become a staple in ergonomic furniture design

The user centric design

“The better you sit, the more you get done.”

Everything about the Kevi chair is visible and purposeful—seat, back, base, and controls. Its design began an ergonomic revolution, transforming workplaces, schools, institutions, and home offices alike.

Recognising that people are built differently, Jørgen Rasmussen introduced flexibility in the backrest, providing support and space for the user’s lower back and spine. The height-adjustable function made the chair accessible and comfortable for users of all heights.

“Some chairs are too technical, but with Kevi we have tried to keep it simple to secure a durable and comfortable chair.”

The lacquered swivel base was launched in powder coated colours in 2023 and can be applied for all Kevi chairs on castors.



KEVI® 2533



The **Kevi 2533** is the closest we come to the original design from 1958.

The frame is a 5 swivel aluminium base with a compression moulded veneer seating and backrest available in oak, white and black lazured veneer as well as 6 Montana colours. The swivel base is also available in 6 Montana colours.

The **Kevi 2533** holds the EU Ecolabel without upholstery.

Kevi 2533 is available in three upholstered versions (app. 1 cm medium soft upholstery):

- Upholstered inner side, seat
- Upholstered inner side, seat & back
- Fully upholstered seat & back



Kevi 2533 holds the DIN EN 1729 (European Standards), TÜV Certificate (German quality, safety and product tests) and GS Certificate (German safety standards).

Kevi 2533 is available with tilt function.
